Terms & Conditions

Prices

Prices to be quoted in GBP (£)/case or Euros (€)/bottle exclusive of VAT, duty (see Quality and storage) and delivery expenses.

Quality and storage

Wines must be in good condition. They must be in original wooden cases (OWC) and these cases need to be properly intact i.e. no broken or splintered cases or any other noticeable defilement, including woodworm. The bottles must have wine at least into the base of the neck, must not have torn or marked labels and no US strips or Far Eastern export labels. We will automatically return or seek to replace any purchases of stock that do not meet these standards.

Wine must have been stored either at the chateau or in a professional bonded warehouse. We are not interested in wine that has had duty paid.

Delivery

We assume vendors will deliver the wine to our account at Vinotheque in Burton-on-Trent (part of London City Bond) at their own expense unless other arrangements have specifically been made.

Orders

Orders placed and accepted by telephone will form a contract subject to written confirmation either by email or by means of invoice.

Payment

Unless otherwise agreed, payment will be made by the fund administrator to the vendor upon delivery and once an inspection of the case and bottles has been made and that the inspection has satisfied the conditions detailed above (see Quality and storage). Payment can be made prior to this inspection if we are provided with photographs of the bottles and the OWC and that these satisfy the same conditions.
